






Pastoral Notes / Prayer Points

Scam Alert

Please be aware that there have recently been several scam attempts, both via text and email mimicking people's legitimate contacts with only a slight change in the details.

If you receive a text or email or asking for help or money, please always double check the email address and/or phone number against the details you have saved in your contacts list for that person. Also, don't click on anything or reply, but first, contact the person directly using the phone number **you** have for them (and not a phone number potentially provided by a scammer), to check whether the text or email is legitimate.

Trinity College Queensland – Activate Program 2024

You may have heard of Activate, the Gap Year program that Trinity College Queensland was relaunching for 2024. It created a lot of positive comments, but we also received some feedback from people who wanted to join Activate while continuing their Uni studies or full-time work. We listened to you and we are excited to announce that we have redesigned Activate to fit into your life, no matter what stage you are at. Activate is <u>no longer</u> a Gap Year program. In other words: keep doing what you're doing and add this into the mix!

Activate is now an add-on program for 18-28 year olds that will transform your perspective on everything else that's going on in your life. You will be part of the Trinity College community, where you will enjoy fun and friendship, learn biblical literacy and life skills, and partner with Interserve, Red Frogs and Scripture Union for mission and outreach.

Activate is about the whole person. Believing that our spiritual life is entirely linked to all areas of our life, we will undertake two fundamental tasks: reading the Bible at the same time as reading life. For a year, we're going to read the Bible as it was intended to be read: for transformation. In this way, we become better equipped to write our own life stories with purpose and conviction as our understanding of the biblical story grows. The program is flexible and convenient, requiring only 21 Wednesday nights for group time, 6 Friday nights for Life Skills, 6 Saturdays for activities and 2 Sundays for mission and outreach. Activate starts on Wednesday 6th March, 2024.

The best part is that the program is very affordable, costing only \$500 for the whole year. And if that's not enough, we also have a scholarship that covers the entire cost for eligible applicants (pretty much everyone who applies). But hurry, because the scholarship is limited and the deadline is approaching fast.

Over the last ten years there has been an explosion of television shows and series focussed on restoration. Shows like The Repair Shop, Fixer Upper, The Block, Flip or Flop all focus on restoring the old and bringing life to the discarded, whether it be houses or the things that go inside them.

This Lent, we invite you to join us as we learn about the greatest restoration project of all time. Over seven weeks we'll focus on God's plan for humankind – a plan for restoration, a plan for new life, a plan that was both unexpected and brilliant. The resources will be based on the lectionary and explore the restoration theme with a toolbox metaphor. Contained within the 7 weeks of material will be reflections and worship themes and suggestions, including interactive and intergenerational elements, prayers, tool fun facts, and restorative practices.

We will be encouraging individuals, families, and communities to undertake a restoration project over the course of Lent, working together to bring to life an old table, chair, cutlery, teddy bear or other item. In addition, there will be a toolbox inscribed with "The Great Restoration Project" and each week, a different tool will be added as a reminder of the weekly content.

From The Word for Today...

Moving from failure to success

'You are snared by the words of your mouth.' Proverbs 6:2 NKJV

A noted psychiatrist remarked that two of the saddest words in human vocabulary are 'if only'. He believes people who get trapped by their failures spend their lives saying, 'If only I had tried harder. If only I had been kinder to my kids. If only I had been more truthful. If only ...' The way to change that mindset is to change your vocabulary by substituting 'if only' with the words 'next time'. 'Next time, I will try harder. Next time, I will be kinder to my kids. Next time, I will be more truthful.'

The Bible says, 'You are snared by the words of your mouth.' And a snare is a trap. Have you ever seen an animal caught in a trap, struggling to be free? Your words can do that. And they don't just affect you; they affect others. Maybe you think we're making too big a deal out of this. If you do – read on: 'A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, but perverseness in it breaks the spirit' (Proverbs 15:4 NKJV). 'Death and life are in the power of the tongue, Aand those who love it will eat its fruit' (Proverbs 18:21 NKJV). Jesus said, '... whoever says to this mountain, "Be removed and be cast into the sea," and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says' (Mark 11:23 NKJV).

What do these Scriptures have in common? They confirm that our words breathe life (or death) into everything! So instead of defeatist talk, speak victory over your situation. Instead of speaking failure, start speaking success. When you do, God will honour the fruit of your lips.
